Volunteer Opportunities within the CRCNA

Christian Reformed World Missions

Nigeria—CRWM is looking for a Special Education Volunteer to serve in Jos, Nigeria for at least a month with flexible dates available in spring, summer or fall of 2011. Partnering with Open Doors, CRWM provides assistance in the development and growth of people with physical and mental disabilities. As a volunteer you will also assist in the developing, planning, and teaching of daily classroom learning activities. Other opportunities include assisting with speech and language therapy, as well as physical strengthening through physiotherapy exercises.



Philippines—Do you have experience in nursing, public health or HIV/AIDS education? CRWM has a volunteer opportunity to promote HIV prevention through workshops in schools and churches in numerous locations throughout the Philippines. You will have the opportunity to build relationships with the community as you live with host families and work alongside Filipino young people. This opportunity takes place in June and goes through July of 2011 for 6-8 weeks.

Ukraine—Be part of an exciting CRWM team this summer in Ukraine. This team will plan a 10-day English camp for young people with intermediate English-language skills who are interested in discussing the Bible. As a team member you will be part of the English camp by sharing testimonies, leading small group Bible studies, organizing English conversation games, teaching some basic English and leading the singing of Christian songs. If you are a college education major or into ESL, this trip is a great opportunity for you! Dates are July 24—August 11, 2011.

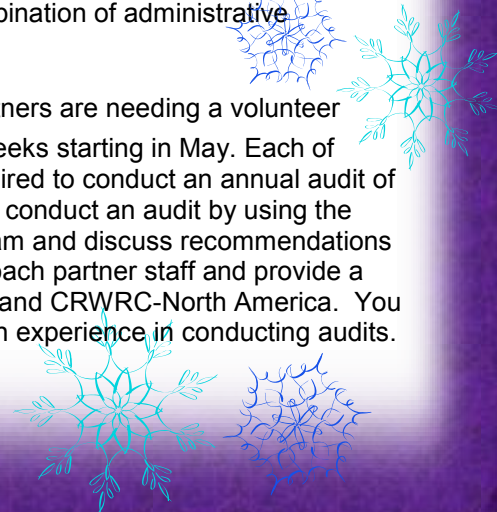

Nigeria—Do you have strong organizational, administrative and HR skills? CRWRC is looking for a Chief Administrative Officer to serve for eight weeks in Jos, Nigeria. Working alongside their partner, The Beautiful Gate Handicapped People Centre, you will facilitate the development of needed processes and procedures to provide human resource structure to the program. You will also meet with staff to provide training and assist them in creating work plans, a staff handbook, evaluations and an accountability structure.

Nigeria—Do you have a knowledge and passion for HIV/AIDS ministry? CRWRC has an opening for a volunteer for at least eight weeks to serve with partner organization, Grace and Light, located in Jos, Nigeria. This ministry works with various churches to promote openness of status in an effort to overcome the culture of stigmatization and secrecy. They also integrate effective prevention with care and support of people living with HIV/AIDS. This position is a combination of administrative responsibilities and ministry.



Senegal—CRWRC and their partners are needing a volunteer auditor in Dakar, Senegal for 3-4 weeks starting in May. Each of CRWRC-Senegal's partners is required to conduct an annual audit of their books. As a volunteer you will conduct an audit by using the CRCNA recommended audit program and discuss recommendations with staff members. You will also coach partner staff and provide a written report for CRWRC-Senegal and CRWRC-North America. You must be an accountant by trade with experience in conducting audits.

- ◆ New Orleans, LA: still working there more than five years after Hurricane Katrina
- ◆ Nashville, Tennessee: rebuilding after floods of this spring
- ◆ Munster, Indiana: recovery from the floods of '08 is far from complete, with indoor work continuing through the winter
